ORDINANCE NO. 2018-04
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
SECTION 50-112 REGARDING ANIMALS IN VILLAGE PARKS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Thiensville Board of Trustees desires to regulate the allowance of animals in village parks; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that regulating the presence of animals in Village of Thiensville parks is in the best interest of the health, general welfare, and safety of Village Residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Thiensville do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 50-112 of the Village of Thiensville is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 50-112-Animals in Parks.

No animal except those placed in the park under the authority of the village are allow in village parks. No person having the control or care of an animal shall suffer or permit such animal to enter or remain in the park. This section shall not apply to dogs under Section 10-32(1)-(5) and “service animals” as defined by section 106.61(1)(fm), Wis. Stats.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
