

**VILLAGE OF THIENSVILLE  
OZAUKEE COUNTY, WISCONSIN  
ORDINANCE NO. 2018-09  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 74-61(2)  
REGARDING STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING**

**WHEREAS**, Wisconsin Statutes sec. 349.06 permits a municipality to enact and enforce any traffic regulation which is in strict conformity with the Wisconsin Statutes;

**WHEREAS**, Wisconsin Statutes sec. 349.13(1d) permits a local authority to enact an ordinance making the owner of the vehicle involved in a violation under section 349.13 jointly liable for a violation for improper stopping, standing or parking of vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board of the Village of Thiensville has considered and desires to establish certain restrictions for stopping, standing and parking within the Village of Thiensville.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Village Board of the Village of Thiensville do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 74-61(2) of the Village Code is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 74-61(2)-Prohibited Parking.**

No person shall, at any time, park in any area posted that parking is prohibited.

Parking is prohibited on any bridge in the Village.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
