



GARBAGE PICK-UP POLICY

Residential Areas

1. All garbage cans or plastic bags must be placed at roadside prior to 7:00 AM the day of pick-up. No garbage may be placed out for pick-up more than 24 hours prior to the scheduled pick-up day. **All empty garbage cans are to be removed from the roadside the same day as your pick-up day. Maximum size of cans is 32 gallons. Maximum weight is 60 pounds.**
2. Garbage pick-up days are Monday or Tuesday mornings. Please call the Village Hall at (262) 242-3720 if you are unsure of what day your pick-up is. If a holiday falls on a Monday, pick-up will be made on Tuesday with Tuesday garbage picked up on Wednesday. Scheduled pick-up begins at 7:00 AM.
3. Ashes and sawdust must be placed in a plastic bag or box, not dumped loosely into garbage cans. This also applies to animal droppings.
4. Barrels, drums, carts or other similar containers or devices will not be emptied.
5. Newspapers, cans, glass bottles and jars, various plastics and empty aerosol cans will **NOT** be collected. **These items must be recycled.**
6. Grass clippings, leaves, pumpkins and all garden refuse must be disposed of by the homeowner or resident. This material may be deposited at the Department of Public Works garage just west of the Post Office on West Freistadt Road. To use compost area, you will need to purchase a Yard Gate Card at the Village Hall. New cards are \$20 and replacement for lost cards are \$10. To enter, approach gate and hold card until you see a green light. The gate will open automatically upon leaving. **YARD GATE CAN ONLY BE USED FOR VILLAGE OF THIENSVILLE RESIDENT USE. NO OUTSIDE REFUSE CAN BE DUMPED. The dumpsters at the yard waste facility are for containers used to transport yard waste only. Household garbage and construction debris are not accepted.**
7. Trees, branches or shrubs with a diameter over 3 inches shall be cut in lengths of 2 feet and stacked at the roadside. Small branches, limbs and brush must be cut to a length not exceeding eight 8 feet and must be bundled with twine or rope. Bundles should not exceed 16 inches in diameter. Christmas trees will be picked up for three weeks following Christmas Day. These materials will be collected on your regular garbage pick-up day, or you may deposit these items at the Department of Public Works yard waste site.
8. Engine oil **WILL NOT** be collected with regular garbage pick-up. Waste engine oil may be deposited at the tank located at the Department of Public Works garage.

YARD WASTE POLICY

1. **Only yard waste from the property associated with the Yard Gate Card in the Village of Thiensville will be accepted.**
2. To use compost area, you will need to purchase a Yard Gate Card at Village Hall, 250 Elm Street. New cards are \$20 and replacement for lost cards are \$10. To enter, approach gate and hold card until you see a green light. The gate will open automatically upon leaving.
3. Grass clippings, leaves and all garden refuse must be disposed of by the homeowner or resident. This material may be deposited at the Department of Public Works garage just west of the Post Office on West Freistadt Road.
